Minimum qualifications: demonstrated interest and capacity to work with young children. Capability to establish a Compassionate Partnership with parents and fellow staff members.

The role of a Nurturer is to create a safe, comfortable family-like environment for the young children in their care. Our expectation is that a Nurturer will create a rich environment to support a child's self-directed learning. This position requires the individual to interact with children individually and in groups. This caring, quality exchange will enhance learning about oneself and the environment. The Nurturer must be able to observe the patterns and rhythms of the children and use these observations to guide their actions. The effective Nurturer is caring, creative and flexible.

Duties may include, but are not limited to:

- Planning with team members
- Deliver educational activities as planned
- Communicate with team members
- Demonstrate flexibility
- Communicate with parents
- Maintain proper records
- Maintain classroom cleanliness
- Supervise children indoors and outdoors
- Be on time for assigned schedule
